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BOTTOMS UP KNITTED KNOCKER PATTERN

(Claudia Barbo and Laureen Furnas)

Materials: 1 set of 7-8 in double pointed needles (4) size 3 mm;
Cascade Ultra Pima cotton; 1 stitch marker; tapestry needle

Gauge: 6 sts = 1 in

Bottom Piece:

Cast on 15 stitches – 5 on each needle leaving 20 inch tail.

Round 1 – K to last stitch, KFB. Repeat on all 3 needles.

Round 2 – KFB, K to last stitch. Repeat on all 3 needles.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until you reach your preferred size:

Sizing (stitches per needle):

A cup – 22; B cup – 24; C cup – 28; D cup – 30; E cup - 32

Turning row: Purl 2 rounds to create edging shape.

Top Piece:

Decrease: K to last 2 stitches on each needle, K2TOG

Repeat on each round until you have 6 stitches left (2 on each needle)

Cut yarn leaving 8 inch tail.

To finish the bottom piece make a draw-string closure by weaving the remaining tail through every other cast-on stitch and tuck rest of tail into hole leaving room to add and remove stuffing as required.
